Accompany students to the hospital in an emergency, as needed
Address individual student's medical needs with parents
Administer first aid to students in clinic
CPR/AED/First Aid Recertification All schools and all departments
Assist with development of health-related policy

Classroom education: Dental, growth and development, hand washing

Collaboration with outside agencies

Determine the health supply needs of clinics and maintain inventory
