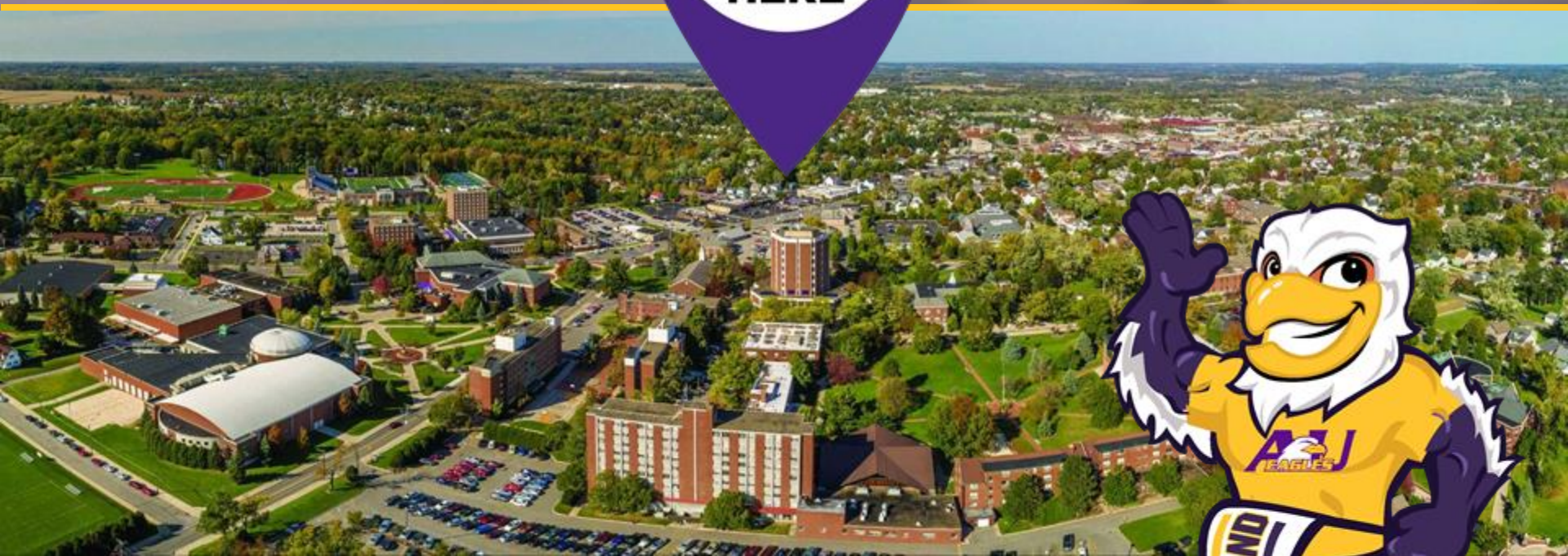






## Admission Requirements

<b>2.50+</b> HS GPA with appropriate ACT, SAT or Accuplacer Scores	<b>3.0+</b> HS GPA without test scores
---	---

For Admission with Assessment Scores:

- 18 ACT composite,
- 960 SAT, or
- ONE of the following Accuplacer scores:  
250 Reading, 263 Writing, or 263 QAS (Math)



The deadline to apply for fall semester is **May 15**; however,

**we suggest submitting your application by**

**APRIL 1<sup>st</sup>**

to be among the first to register for classes on April 15th.

# SCHOLARSHIP



*All high school students (in the Class of 2024 and beyond) who are enrolled in the College Credit Plus program at AU and matriculate directly from high school into a bachelor's program will receive a yearly \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 to be awarded in the fall semester and \$500 in the spring semester). This scholarship is renewable yearly (for up to four years or \$4,000) and is stackable upon other scholarships/aid.*
