**Groups**

- Each Group will have approximately 50% of the students in the building and in the classrooms
- Groups would stay together throughout the time of the Healthy Restart Plan
- Groups would be thoughtfully constructed to ensure students in a household are on the same schedule
- Groups will be formed and shared with families no later than August 3<sup>rd</sup>

**In-Person Learning Days**

- Students will begin their school day at the regular start times for their building
- Students will engage in their typical school day work during this time ranging from discussions, projects, labs, assessment, feedback etc.
- Last day of the In-Person instructional week will prepare students for the Remote Learning activities/assignments to be completed until the next In-Person Learning Day
- End times of the In-Person school day will be adjusted slightly to provide teachers a block of time at the end of each instructional day for online support of students in remote learning.

**Remote Learning Days**

- Remote Learning Activities will be posted in Canvas for students and families to access at any time
- Activities and assignments will be aligned to the instruction provided during the In-Person Learning Days
- Activities will utilize the digital learning tools available at each grade level (ie. - ScootPad, ST Math, Lexia, EnVision, etc.)
- Enrichment and Intervention services *may* be provided through virtual lessons and meetings on Remote Learning Days
- Teachers will have a block of time available at the end of each instructional day for online support of students in remote learning

## Option 2 DCS Online Academy Sample Schedule

The DCS Online Academy is a completely separate learning environment from the Option 1, Blended Learning model.

During the course of a student's "school day" in the Online Academy, students will be interacting with their teacher within the following instructional strategies:

- Synchronous Lessons
- Small Group / Individual Support Activities
- Asynchronous Lessons
- Individual learning activities within digital tools available at each grade level
- The DCS Online Academy will have a foundational digital resource that will allow teachers and students to work through curriculum and courses that students will need for each grade level. (including Honors and Advanced Placement courses)

There will be flexibility built into the Online Academy schedule to allow teachers and students to interact with each other and the curriculum at various times throughout the instructional week.

The instructional strategies listed below will allow for a robust, interactive learning experience for students at every grade level

### Synchronous Lessons

- Synchronous Lessons are those the teacher will schedule with their students to deliver direct instruction through the use of a video conferencing tool
- These lessons will be an appropriate length for the grade level
- These lessons will be taught by our Delaware City Schools teachers
- Some synchronous lessons may be recorded and posted to Canvas for those unable to attend at the specified time

### Small Group / Individual Support Activities

- Teachers may select a small group or an individual student to meet with through our video conferencing tool
- These activities will provide additional instruction and support beyond the synchronous lesson

### Asynchronous Lessons

- Asynchronous Lessons are those lessons/activities/assignments that the teacher will create for the student to access at any time. These lessons are not "live."
- These lessons will be an appropriate length for the grade level
- These lessons will be taught by our Delaware City Schools teachers

### Digital Learning Tools

- Individual activities within the DCS Online Academy will utilize the digital learning tools available at each grade level
  - i.e. - ScootPad, Lexia, EnVision, etc.
- The district will work with families to ensure access to devices and internet to support learning in the DCS Online Academy.
